Using Personalised Stories to Increase Reading Engagement

Many children struggle to connect with traditional texts. Personalised storytelling helps make reading **relevant, meaningful and exciting** by placing children at the very centre of the story — transforming reluctant readers into enthusiastic participants.

1

Story of the Week

Create a personalised story featuring a pupil, class mascot or familiar theme. Read together as a class, then discuss characters, choices and predictions.

2

Reluctant Reader Challenge

Allow pupils to create stories based on their own interests. Encourage independent reading followed by discussion and compare engagement with traditional activities.

3

Reading Circle

Small groups read different personalised stories, then compare characters, themes and endings before presenting findings to the class.

Turning Reading into Creative Writing

AI-generated stories provide a powerful starting point for creativity. The story becomes the **beginning of the learning journey** rather than the finished product — inspiring pupils to imagine, plan, draft and refine their own writing.



Rewrite the Ending

Generate a story, then challenge pupils to create alternative endings. Compare and discuss the different outcomes and what makes each one effective.



Expand the Adventure

Add extra chapters, introduce new characters, or create sequels and spin-off stories to extend the narrative and deepen engagement.



Genre Exploration

Generate stories in different genres — suspense, mystery, adventure, fantasy — and explore how language and structure change across each one.



Story Improvement Challenge

Ask pupils to improve sections of the AI-generated story, focusing specifically on vocabulary, description and dialogue to sharpen their editing skills.

Introducing AI in a Safe and Meaningful Way

Children are growing up in a world where AI is increasingly common. Schools have a vital opportunity to help pupils **understand how it works**, explore its strengths, recognise its limitations and develop responsible, critical attitudes towards its use.

Classroom Activities

1 How Did AI Create This Story?

Discuss what information the AI used, why it made certain choices and what role the prompt played in shaping the output.

2 Human vs AI

Compare an AI-generated story with a pupil-written story. Discuss similarities, differences and what each brings to the reader.

3 Fact, Fiction or Imagination?

Identify realistic and fictional elements within a story and discuss the balance between creativity and accuracy in AI output.

Key Discussion Questions

- Can AI be truly creative?
- What makes a story genuinely engaging?
- How important is the human author?
- When should AI be used — and when should it not?



These conversations build **critical thinking, digital literacy** and responsible AI use — essential skills for 21st-century learners.

Simple Ways to Trial YourStoryWorld

One-Week Reading Challenge

Creative Writing Topic

Use a generated story as the starting point for a class discussion about artificial intelligence — what it is, how it works and what it means for the future.
